A state of anarchy now exists in Nassau County. Two things can be done now.



If someone has a proposal needing the endorsement of the Nassau County FLP a set amount of notification must be given to all members and a minimum number of members would have to be present at such a meeting.

2. Anyone wanting to fill any of the four offices should notify me and I will send out a mail ballot to the membership.
