Motion by Andrew Kolstee to demote resigned Delegate to the Libertarian National Convention Joseph Sabin and promote Erin Becker to Delegate to the Libertarian National Convention was seconded by Anthony D'Orazio, debated, and passed by voice vote.

William Cody Anderson issued a report on the search for a new Chair of the Public Engagement Committee. Jacob Cornell and Duane Whitmer are both interested in the position.

The next meeting of the Executive Committee was set for Thursday, May 19, 2022 at 9:00 p.m. without objection.

Duane Whitmer requested that the Libertarian Party of New York request the Libertarian National Committee that New York delegates be allowed to participate remotely since the National Convention occurs during the last week of statewide petitioning. The Chair indicated that he would make such a request.
