CiviCRM. Kolstee mentioned progress made on the customer relationship management software with national. Libertarian Party has a Slack group with discussion.

Yahoo Groups. Due to Yahoo's sale to Verizon, the future of Yahoo Groups is uncertain. Kolstee suggested that research and keep in mind alternatives in the event that Yahoo Groups is closed. An LPNY slack channel was created at lpny.slack.com so that option can be explored.

Domain and Hosting. Earlier it was decided that "lp.ny.org" shall be our public URL address and the only one we promote even though we have others including lpnewyork.org and lpny.us. The hosting plan ends in 2019, and it was agreed that we shall consider moving our website to national's Wordpress multisite.

Google Analytics. Google Analytics reports go back to July 2017. Kolstee reviewed analytics and look into landing pages as far as the domain is concerned. It was determined that Kolstee may be the only person accessing the website through "lpnewyork.org" and thus a switch over in 2019 would be smooth. Additionally, Kolstee will figure out how to send an invite so Dowden can access those reports as well.
