Executive Committee Minutes — January 13, 2001

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Mark Bodenhausen.

The minutes were read and approved with amendments.

Treasurer's Report: We have a balance in checking account #1 of \$1,605.67 and checking account #2 \$3,313.36

District Reports:

Birmingham. Freeman reported that the guest was David Langum of the ACLU of Alabama, also a law professor at Cumberland. There was good attendance at the meeting and a nice discussion of the issues.

Huntsville. The meeting was held at the Piccadilly in Madison Square Mall with 15 people present and an overall good meeting took place.

Mobile. Mark Bodenhausen visited and there was a good meeting in Mobile.

Selma. Kevin Andrews reported a good meeting/ Christmas party and that he is currently working on a history of the LPA.

Auburn. Scott reported that there were going to be Operation Politically Homeless Booths at AU on Jan 22 and Jan 23. Dick Clark also mentioned that he is currently working on a benefit concert for the LPA that is tentatively scheduled for April 20, 2002.

Montevallo. Amy Wood spoke of the opportunities for candidates at the university and encouraged everyone to come and visit the university for campaigning and outreach.

Secretary's report. Margi Crook was unable to attend the meeting due to poor health. She sent a Report on Theresa Wilson and her current status in Alabama Corrections.

Vice Chairman's Report. Matthew Givens spoke of his activities with SB36 and the eventual passage of the bill into law. However the bill in its final version affects the LPA only minimally. Matthew has scheduled a couple of speeches to non-libertarian groups in the immediate future.

Chairman's Report. Mark Bodenhausen had call and spoke with the Governor's attorney as to SB36 but apparently to no avail. He also reported that our political signs were not printed due to the printer awaking to an "unexpected anniversary."

He reported that the signs should be available very soon however. He also has been in contact with Birmingham City Councilman Joel Montgomery about various issues and has high hopes for his occupancy on the council.

Administrator's Report. Mike Rster reported that the Billboard was up but had received minimal response. He added that the next step would need to be getting the political signs put up. Kevin Andrews requested an exact legal definition of political signs and their place on the highways. Mike mentioned the need to avoid a "sign war." He also spoke of the upcoming Convention for April 13th and 14th. Currently our guests include Dr. Jimmy Blake, James Lark, and possibly Eli Israel. Mike also spoke of the meeting that he and the Chairman attended with CH; the focus needing to be proactive activities as opposed to passive outreach; in addition the ideas that we need to be a safe alternative for people wishing to be in politics. There was discussion as to the Registered Voter list and the proposed price tag by the Alabama office of over \$30,000 for a CD of registered voters in the State of Alabama.



Old Business. There was extensive discussion as to making the LPA database available but secure to our candidates. After much commentary the decision that the candidates with certain provisions would have access to the database. These provisions required a signed contract and included a destroy date as well as penalties for abuse.


their taxes. MasterCard International Ltd. is also in negotiations with the government.




