2023 ELECTION RESULTS: 6 CANDIDATES WIN ELECTIONS

The 2023 election season is over and we almost have the official results. Some counties have certified election results, but not all. The deadline for certification is in early December, but the results are mostly complete.

There were Libertarian candidates across the state running for office for the 2023 elections. Of the 18 candidates, 6 Libertarians won their races.

In Chautauqua County, Ryan Sanders was re-elected as Sherman Village Trustee running for one of two positions in a race with only two candidates.

In Steuben County, Angela Einwachter was re-elected to Prattsburgh Town Council in a two-way race with two seats available.

In Oneida County, there were two victories. Oneida County Libertarian Party Chair Keith Redhead was elected Ava Town Supervisor in a contested two-way race against Republican candidate David C. Mathis, Sr. Also in the Town of Ava, Kathleen Redhead was elected as Ava Tax Collector—the first victory for the Libertarian Party of New York for that type of office.

In the Town of Marilla in Erie County, cross-endorsed candidates Earl Gingerich, Jr. won his

race for Town Supervisor while Sharon Forersch won her race for Town Clerk.

HELP US GET A3312 REINTRODUCED

This bill, from the 2023 legislative session, would have lowered the ballot access thresholds back to the previous standards: the number of votes needed to get ballot access to 50,000 (from 130,000 or 2%), and lower the petition signature requirement for a statewide office to 15,000 (from 45,000). Contact your representatives in the New York State Legislature and ask them to support reintroducing this bill for the 2024 legislative session!

UPDATES FROM THE CHAIR

Here is this month's update on some of the things going on behind the scenes at the Libertarian Party of New York.

State Committee

The next State Committee meeting will be held on Monday, December 4, 2023. We have vacancies remaining on the committee that can be filled at this meeting. We will also be electing our Platform and Credentials Committee representatives for the 2024 Libertarian National Convention at that meeting.

2024 Nominating Convention

The Libertarian Party of New York will hold a nominating convention to choose our placeholder candidates for President and Vice President.

The Libertarian National Convention will be held at the end of the petitioning period, and so when petitioning begins, it is unknown who the nominee will be, and so a placeholder candidate would need to be selected

in order to get a candidate on the ballot. If the Libertarian Party of New York has a successful petitioning drive, the placeholder candidate is able to withdraw in favor of the candidate selected at the Libertarian National Convention.

We will also choose our U.S. Senate candidate. We are looking for bids for the location, in which the Executive Committee is to finalize sometime in December.

2024 National Convention

The 2024 Libertarian National Convention is scheduled for May 2024 in Washington, D.C. Delegate numbers are locked in, and New York will have 41 delegate spots.

If you would like to be a delegate, a form has been sent out for interested individuals to sign up. We will be choosing our delegates in early 2024. Emails will be sent to remind everyone about the form and to apply to be a delegate.

Ballot Access Legislation

Works continues on the website, but most of the work has been focused on the database, in which there are a few remaining tasks to complete the migration.

2024 Campaign

The Petitioning Committee has met and is exploring ideas for a potential statewide petitioning drive in 2024. If you are interested in joining this committee, please reach out.

Platform Committee

The Platform Committee, chaired by Dan Castello, is currently working on revamping the state platform. When the work is completed, a series of proposals will be sent to the State Committee for consideration to amend the platform.
