Good afternoon to the Executive Board of the Libertarian Party of Idaho:

It has come to my attention since sending the previous email (containing minutes from what are purported to be central committee meetings in Ada County) that no Precinct Committeeman candidate for the LPID in Ada County achieved the 5 votes that (according to Idaho § 34-1208) are required to win the office. Phaedra Mitchell at Ada County Elections pointed this statute out to me last night, in response to an email I sent to each Idaho county's Clerk's office. That email was sent to seek out the contact information of all duly elected precinct committeemen, so that we could properly form the State Central Committee, on which I now have learned I will not sit.

I am certain I am not the only one who made this error in ignorance of §34-1208. In response to my email, Kylie Marks of the Canyon County Elections Office informed me that Zachary Callear won the office; however, according to the unofficial election results on the Secretary of State's website, he received only 2 votes, shy of the 5 needed. Based on the topics of discussion at the previous Executive Board meeting, I would guess that like his county clerk, Mr. Callear is operating under the same mistaken impression as I was.

I would recommend that, because this error appears common among private citizens and government officials alike, the board reach out to any Libertarian who has informed the board of an election to a County or Legislative District Central Committee position, inform them of §34-1208, and come to one of two resolutions with each member:

1. Come to a mutual recognition that the Central Committee meetings were invalid because the purported Precinct Committeemen were operating under the same mistaken assumption as myself, Ms. Marks, and Mr. Callear, and had not received the 5 requisite votes; or,
2. Come to a mutual recognition that the Central Committee meetings were valid, because the Precinct Committeeman involved had received the 5 requisite votes, whether or not he knew of §34-1208.

Based on the unofficial election results from the Idaho Secretary of State, I believe that the only member for whom the 2nd option applies is Mr. Todd Corsetti. All other Libertarian Precinct Committeeman candidates I have found in the results received less than 5 votes.
