William P. McMillen, a thirty-nine year old resident of Saratoga County, is the Free Libertarian Party candidate for Comptroller of the State of New York.

A certified public accountant with fifteen years of experience in accounting, taxation, and auditing, McMillen has been active in the New York State Society of Certified Public Accountants at the State and local level, having served on the State Professional Conduct Committee and the Professional Development and Public Relations Committee of the Albany Chapter.

In addition to managing his own accounting practice providing financial, accounting and tax service to an assortment of small businesses and individuals, he also teaches accounting courses at a local college.

McMillen is currently vice-chairman of the Capital District Libertarian Party and has served as a delegate to the National Libertarian Convention in 1979 and 1981, Presidential elector for Ed Clark in 1980 and media coordinator for the Capital District Party.

A magna cum laude graduate of Bryant College in Providence Rhode Island, McMillen refused induction into the armed services in 1965 for which he served 26 months in prison.
