

MEETING SUMMARY June 20, 2023

The meeting was called to order at 5:35pm Mountain time.

Records of Past Meetings: The minutes of the 6 June meeting were approved without objection.

Site Statistics: Ed reported that the statistics look reasonably good. We seem to have recovered from Google "temporarily hating us", with our pages being recommended less often but with higher click rates. The most frequent searches relate to the 2024 presidential election.

Video Digitization: Caryn Ann reported that a batch of tapes has been shipped to Tom at the Museum of Broadcast History; shipping was \$71 but the cost of the digitization won't be known until it is done because it depends on the actual length of the recordings. This batch consisted of the remaining 2-inch tapes plus 12 VHS cassettes; the VHS ones will be done at higher resolution than some have been done in the past.

California: Joe reported that the state HPC is continuing to meet monthly.

Wisconsin: James reported that Wisconsin now has an HPC chaired by Tyler Danke.

Library of Congress: Caryn Ann noted that it will soon be time to check with them about the status of the Nolan collection; she may try to visit them in person when she is in DC for the LNC meeting.



2024 Convention Memorial Committee: Caryn Ann said that the last national email about this did get some response from potential volunteers.

Wisconsin (continued): Tyler Danke joined the call and said their state HPC started three weeks ago and has three members. Both he and the current Vice Chair have a lot of material that they are interested in digitizing. He is also the Secretary of the state party and ran on a platform of making minutes and other party documents available through LPedia.

The next meeting is scheduled for 18 July 2023 (skipping the usual First Tuesday, which falls this year on 4 July).
