

Minutes of the meeting of the State Central Committee of the Libertarian Party of Idaho 30 June 2022

Meeting called to order at 7:05 PM MDT by Mr. Sorensen. The Agenda was proposed:

The Roll Call revealed that there were 4 of 5 voting members of the State Central Committee present (3 officers and one SCC committeeman); this was a quorum, with a majority (if all vote) of 3. The Secretary initially reported that Mr. Ward was a voting member, but it has since been realized that he was a guest, as only the officers of the LPID are also voting members of the SCC. The count as reported was correct.

There were no action items except those encountered in the course of presentation of reports.

The Chair presented his report regarding the controversy surrounding the 2 April LPID Convention.

The Secretary presented his report correcting the minutes of the 20 June meeting of the State Central Committee. In the motion offered by Mr Corsetti to fill the LPID Chair vacancy, those minutes contained an error in the Bylaws quote, as “The State Central Committee shall appoint new officers if vacancies or suspensions occur” which was incorrectly quoted as “The State Central Committee shall appoint new officers of vacancies or suspensions occur”. It was confirmed that the original (Bylaws) text is correct, and the error was introduced in copying the original text. **The Secretary proposed** that the error be corrected and the minutes be adopted as amended. There was no objection. The corrected minutes will be distributed.

Mr Corsetti presented his report of the SCC and recounted SCC actions.

Public Comment:

Mr Cobbler left at 7:46.

There was much discussion of the issues surrounding the events reported by the Chair regarding the legitimacy of the 2 April 2022 Convention.

It was also noted that the resolution at the end of the 2 April Convention was not referenced in the minutes. The Secretary will correct that oversight.
