Ed Clark is an attorney. As the LP candidate for Governor of California in 1978 he received more than 370,000 votes which was over 5.5% of those cast. He is currently seeking the 1980 presidential nomination of the Libertarian Party.

Bill Hunscher, a New Hampshire businessman, was the first announced candidate for the 1980 LP presidential nomination. He is the Chairman of the New Hampshire LP whose 1978 slate of legislative candidates made impressive showings.

Michael Emerling is an author, lecturer, and political consultant whose seminars have drawn rave reviews across the country. He has participated in more than 33 campaigns and will speak on Communicating Libertarian Ideas.
