TUCCILLE SAYS "DON'T TRUST POLITICIANS!"

"The recent public repudiation of two prominent politicians indicates a growing dissatisfaction with current politics," said Jerry Tuccille (pronounced "two-chilly") at his Westchester campaign headquarters today.

The Free Libertarian Party gubernatorial candidate cautioned each voter "not to trust politicians--including myself."

Continued Tuccille: "Two events in the news this week indicate a growing popular sentiment which can only be described as "anti-politician." President Ford was booed by crowds because of his pardon of Richard Nixon. And in Boston, parents angered over the busing of their children to distant schools taunted Ted Kennedy and pelted him with eggs.

"Such outbursts of public resentment are entirely understandable," said the candidate. "Our elected leaders have been displaying incredibly poor judgment, and the people recognize it. Politicians can expect more of this public anger if they continue to make the innocent citizen a victim of taxation and regimentation while simultaneously exonerating their far less innocent political friends."

"Turning to the recent New York State primary election, Tuccille commented: "Not only was the overall turnout unusually low, but those who did vote emphatically rejected the establishment candidates.

"Clearly, New York State voters are searching for a new political alternative. Libertarianism represents the antithesis of the power politics that has dominated this State for more than 30 years."
