- -DA's office handles approximately 7000 cases per year. Staff of investigators, specialized prosecutors, and victims coordinators office.
 - -\$2.3 million annual budget
 - -Favors reform of new bail and discovery laws
 - -Wants to keep juveniles (16-17 year olds) out of the adult criminal justice system
