There are concerns by some individuals about Larry Sharpe running as the stand-in candidate and not stepping down in favor of the candidate nominated at the National Convention.

Motion by Mark Braiman to send out the email he drafted regarding the recruitment of down ballot candidates was seconded by Steven Becker. Motion by Christopher Olenski to amend the motion to add a link for people to fill out a form if they are interested in running for office or petitioning was seconded by Jennifer O'Connor and passed without objection. The main motion to send out the email he drafted regarding the recruitment of down ballot candidates passed as amended without objection.

Steven Becker suggested that Robert F. Kennedy, Jr. could be recruited to run as the Libertarian Party's U.S. Senate candidate. In the event he pursues the National nomination, he would be ineligible to be the Presidential stand-in; this would be a workaround.
