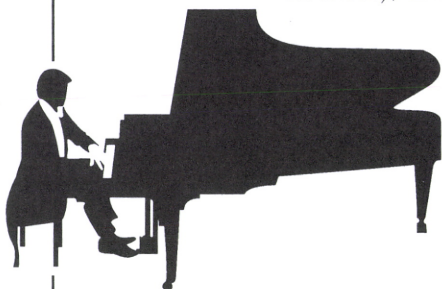
Gala Honors & Awards Banquet
