

At the Organizing Convention of the Free Libertarian Party, Mid-Hudson Area, held at the Unitarian Fellowship, on Thursday evening, April 17, 1975, Ms. P. Jean Carroll in the chair, and Ms. Serena Stockwell acting as Secretary, an agenda for that meeting was adopted.

Rules for this Convention were adopted as proposed by Mr. Guy Riggs.

Guy Riggs moved adoption of the By-laws for this organization. Ellen Davis proposed an amendment to Article II, Section 3 to include "Westchester" county between Putnam and Ulster. Ms. Davis's motion was seconded and carried. Guy Riggs proposed an amendment to Article VI, Section 1 of the addition of the sentence "All Party meetings shall be called by the Executive Committee consistent with Article VIII" at the end of this section. The amendment was seconded and adopted. The By-laws for the Free Libertarian Party, Mid-Hudson Area were adopted.

The Convention Rules for this organization were proposed by Mr. Riggs, seconded, and adopted.

The election of Party officers proceeded. Guy Riggs nominated Sanford Cohen as Chairperson. The nomination of Mr. Cohen was seconded and he was unanimously elected Chairperson. Sanford Cohen nominated Guy Riggs as Vice-Chairperson. The nomination of Mr. Riggs was seconded and he was elected Vice-Chairperson unanimously. Mr. Cohen nominated Vivian Wadlin as Secretary. The nomination of Ms. Wadlin was seconded and she was unanimously elected Secretary. Carole Cohen nominated Brenda Hicks as Treasurer. The nomination of Ms. Hicks was seconded and she was unanimously elected Treasurer. Guy Riggs nominated P. Jean Carroll for State Representative. The nomination of Ms. Carroll was seconded and she was unanimously elected State Representative. Sanford Cohen nominated Vivian Wadlin as Alternate State Representative. The nomination of Ms. Wadlin was seconded and she was unanimously elected as Alternate State Representative.

A motion to lay on the table was made by Sanford Cohen for the election of the Members-at-large for the Candidate Selection Committee. This motion was seconded and passed.

Ellen Davis moved to adjourn, it was agreed to and the meeting ended.
