MEETING SUMMARY March 20, 2019

Records of Past Meetings: The minutes of the 6 March meeting were approved.

Site Statistics: Ed reported that nothing exciting is happening with the statistics. He mentioned that there is a report that shows what state users are coming from, that Colorado, New York, and California are most commonly in the top three, but this time Virginia was one of the top three. He said he is considering adding some basic logging to the home page to be able to get some statistics independent of Google.

LPedia URLs: It was noted that this change has not happened yet.

California: Joe reported that the LPC HPC is proceeding with their plan to have a table at the state convention, being held the first weekend in April.
