MEETING SUMMARY July 16, 2024

The meeting was called to order at 4:40pm Mountain time.

**Records of Past Meetings:** The minutes of the 2 July meeting were approved without objection.

**Site Statistics and Technical:** Sam mentioned that he plans to meet with Ed Fochler soon about getting the access needed to be able to report statistics.

**Alabama:** Sam said he is still going through boxes of historical information relating to the state party. He now has an AI assistant “Mycroft”, based on GPT-4, that he has been having create transcripts and summaries of state party meetings and hopes to also use to automatically create LPedia articles based on scanned documents. His goal is to develop it into a tool that can help all affiliates with such tasks, and add additional functions like providing live minutes and parliamentary advice during a meeting.

**California:** Joe said very little seems to be happening with the state party; it is unclear whether they even understand what needs to be done to get our presidential ticket on the ballot.

**Personal Collections:** Sam said he bought three issues of Southern Libertarian Messenger through eBay but it turned out we already have those issues in LPedia. Caryn Ann said she thinks we have additional issues in storage that have not yet been uploaded.

**Convention Memorial Committee:** Lisa reported that she worked on articles about two people who recently died – David Boaz and Mark Glogowski. She will be improving the tracking of who has already been included in the memorial presentations, to avoid duplicates or missing somebody.
