

MINUTES OF THE LIBERTARIAN PARTY OF NEW YORK STATE
COMMITTEE TELECONFERENCE, JUNE 3, 2007

A quorum was established and Chairman Russell called the meeting to order at 2000.

Mr. Jonathan Levine introduced himself, proposing to run for mayor of Ardsley. Dr. Stevens proposed endorsement. (Passed unanimously.)

May 6 minutes were approved without objection.

Dr. Garvey moved to remove Ithaca chapter from quorum requirement until that chapter notifies LPNY of the election of a representative to the state committee. (Passed on voice vote.)

Dr. Stevens moved appropriating \$1,000 for publication and dissemination of fundraising letter asking for automatic monthly pledges. (Passed on voice vote.)

Members discussed setting time and place for 2008 LPNY convention, and contacting possible speakers including Presidential candidates.

Dr. Stevens introduced the following resolution: "LPNY supports the call for a referendum demanding an independent investigation of the events of 9/11." Mr. Dobrian moved to postpone the motion until more exact wording were presented. (Postponed without objection.)

Mr. Edes moved that a letter be sent to the municipal government of Portchester, endorsing an at-large voting system in local election.

Mr. Dobrian moved to postpone the motion until an actual letter was presented for LPNY's approval. (Failed 6-5 on chairman's casting vote.) Original motion passed 6-5 on chairman's casting vote.

The meeting was adjourned at 2140.
