With a new year comes exciting new opportunities. As a result of Libertarian Gubernatorial Candidate Larry Sharpe receiving over 90,000 votes in 2018, the Libertarian Party of New York has become an officially recognized political party in New York State, for the first time since its founding in 1973.

We are now taking that momentum and moving forward. Our structure will be changing as we shift to the system defined by New York State election law.

We are going to run a substantial number of candidates in the coming year, especially as we have a great opportunity to put Libertarians on the ballot, without the need for petitioning. In addition, we will have lower petitioning requirements in the coming years. This will free up money previously consumed by petitioning. Those funds will now be available for promoting our candidates (mailings, advertising, signs, and so on). Those funds will be spent in a way that the voters will see.

Please renew your membership for 2019 and, if you can, send an additional donation. 2019 is very likely the last year that we will collect dues. When the officially recognized political party convenes, membership will be based on
