MEETING SUMMARY August 1, 2023

Date and Time: Tuesday, 1 August 2023 at 5:30pm Mountain time

Where: Online: Zoom

The meeting was called to order at 5:35pm Mountain time.

Templates: James reported on a new template "Infobox Major" for use with material saved from Wikipedia; there was discussion of whether this was really needed and if so whether it should have a different name.

Site Statistics: Ed reported that the numbers have been pretty boring but there seems to be a bit of an increase; the most common searches relate to the platform and candidates as well as "Delta Asher Hill".

Site Technical: Ed reported that somebody who wanted to sign up for the site was not able to find the page to do that because of the way the menu gets truncated on mobile devices; this is one of a number of ways in which we are not serving mobile devices well.

Alabama: Sam reported that they are making a video about the history of ballot access there, as a way to raise awareness of the issue; proposals for improvements have been made in the legislature but without success so far.

Scan Uploading: Sam reported that he finished the issues of "Time for Liberty".

2024 Convention Memorial Committee: Lisa cited some examples of people who might or might not be included in the memorial, based on factors like what they did after being involved in the LP or whether their death has not yet been publicly announced, and asked for feedback from committee members. She said she has so far identified as many as 22 people who might be included. She suggested that if the

video turns out to be very long, we might want to display it at our table rather than trying to show the whole thing in the main hall. This led to a discussion of what else we might have at our table. Caryn Ann said she will be asking for a table but that we are not guaranteed to get one, and that even if we do we should not try to bring as much material as last time.

Video Digitization: Caryn Ann said there was no progress to report yet on the current order.

Gary Johnson Videos: Joe reported that he was in communication with the activist who has videos made by Gary Edward Johnson, and that the activist had provide copies of several samples that he had already gotten digitized, along with a spreadsheet listing information about all the videos in the set (based on external labels).
