## Key Background Details

---

- Before the 2022 May Idaho primary election, several people in the state declared candidacy for the office of Precinct Committeeman for the Libertarian Party. Per [Idaho Statutes 34-1208](#), wherein five votes are required to be elected, only Todd Corsetti of Bannock County, was duly elected. Within 10 days following the primary election, he held a meeting of the Bannock County Libertarian Central Committee, as the only member, wherein he elected himself chairman and his wife state committeewoman. He's affiliated with the Libertarian Party Mises Caucus.
- At the May 24th, 2022 Executive Board meeting (the last before the Libertarian National Convention), discussion was had as to where to hold the 2022 state convention. A motion was made by Adam Belnap (Treasurer) that we have it in Region 1 (northern Idaho). Zach Callear, as Vice Chair, made a point of order to mention that while the Executive Board may make this decision, it's possible it may be overruled by the SCC in accordance with [Idaho Statutes 34-707](#), which says the convention is to be held "at a time and place determined by the state central committee". The point of order was well taken, even though Zach's intention was not that we not make the decision at all, and Adam withdrew his motion.
- On May 31st, 2022, the day after returning from the 2022 Libertarian National Convention (Vice Chair Zach Callear, Treasurer Adam Belnap and Region 1 Chair Chris Ward) noticed the following:
  - They no longer had access to their @lpid.org email accounts.

- The [website's Leadership page](#) had been reverted to show the Executive Board as it had been immediately before the 2022 convention. Effectively, its result is that the three members of the Executive Board affiliated with the Libertarian Party Mises Caucus, Zach Callear, Adam Belnap, and Chris Ward, were no longer listed as members, while the four other members were all still listed as members.
- Documents had been presented to the Secretary of State confirming these changes. It should be noted in two months since the convention. No attempt was ever made to inform the SOS of changes to the board following convention. Also, Robert Imhoff presented himself on these documents as Acting Treasure. Even though he had been notified numerous times of his inability to hold that office regarding a conflict of interest pre April 2<sup>nd</sup> convention

  - An email was sent that evening from [newsletter@lpid.org](mailto:newsletter@lpid.org), subject "2022 Idaho Compliance Notification - State Executive Board", attached) claiming, in essence, that according to statutes, the 2022 convention's results were void.
- On June 20th, 2022, the State Central Committee held a meeting. Both versions of the Executive Board's members were given notice, including providing the proposed agenda, and both Robert and Jennifer Imhoff-Dousharm were served through a professional document service, as they were direct subjects of the agenda. In that meeting:
  - Robert was suspended as Chair.
  - Jayson Sorensen was appointed as the interim Chair until the next convention, or upon a successful appeal by Robert Imhoff
  - Jennifer was suspended as Chair insofar as she held any claim to that position, albeit unrecognized by the SCC.
  - The task of considering and optionally acting upon the expulsion of both Robert and Jennifer as members of the LPID was delegated to the Judicial Committee.
  - The setting of the time and location of the next convention was delegated to the Executive Board.

- A motion was passed declaring April, 2022 convention valid and binding upon the LPID.
- Dan Karlan, both the Secretary of the 2020 and 2022 boards, a well-respected member of the party and a stickler for rules, is on our side of this.

I will attach all documents we as a board find related to these incidents.
