2023-11 AFFILIATES - Affiliate Rep / Mesa County Report

Per Article V, Section 1, of the [2023 Libertarian Party of Colorado Bylaws](#), the following is the controlling language for my position:

Article V, Section 1. Affiliates... e) [Every organization so chartered] ... shall also submit contact information for their officers/directors, who shall include at least a Chair and a Treasurer, being separate people. They shall maintain at least five (5) Party Members, publish their bylaws to those Members and the State Board of Directors, and file their initial Fair Campaign Practices Act filings as necessary.
