THE DEMOCRATIC CANDIDATES

"There's no essential difference between the two Democratic candidates for governor," declared Jerry Tuccille (pronounced "two-chilly") today.

Tuccille, an independent candidate for governor, denounced Howard J. Samuels and Hugh L. Carey for their virtually identical stands on the major issues. "Both candidates subscribe to the same liberal ideology, which claims that 'more government' is the solution to every problem. I think we've all come to realize in the past few years that just the opposite is true, that government is in fact the cause of most of our problems."

There's an alternative which the two Democrats ignore, said Tuccille. "Reduce the size and scope of government and give people the freedom to solve their own problems."

Tuccille demonstrated his point by referring to a major issue of the campaign: taxes and inflation. "Mr. Samuels and Mr. Carey profess concern about high taxes. But they also favor expanded government programs and services, which means more taxing and spending by the State."

"You can't have it both ways. Forty-eight percent of all Americans believe government to be most responsible for inflation --and they're right. The only proper solution is to reduce the power of the government to borrow, tax and spend, substituting private enterprise for government services."
