LPNY Communications Division Report Sunday, January 7, 2018

Summary

- New TCCs have been added to the website and the map has been updated.
- A recent blog post by Alex Merced generated over 1,500 unique page views on the website.
- Four people applied for the Political Director through the online application.
- One person volunteered to help run the Twitter account.
- The last two e-mail campaigns have just over 730 readers each.
- National data for New York has been loaded to the CiviCRM database.
- CiviCRM is moving from WPEngine to Civihosting.
- Independent Voter Network published an article in response to our MOVE Act press release.

I. Project Reports

A. Website

- Small Updates. Oswego and Essex County pages added. Map of New York on affiliates page updated.
- Official e-mail addresses. Once you confirm that you have opened your LPNY e-mail address, (for example, mine is akolstee@ny.lp.org), let me know so I can change your listing on the website. If you have any questions about setting up your e-mail or need an account, talk to Mike Dowden.
- Officers and At-Large Biographies. I need biographies and photos for all officers and At-Large Committee Members. I inserted some information for each person, but still need additional biographical information and photographs.

- **LPNY Blog Highlights.** Alex Merced's blog post "10 Reasons New York Needs A New Governor" generated 1,587 page views (1,524 unique page views). The home page has had 4,810 views over the past year and the affiliates page has had 510 page views over the past year. These are the top three most viewed pages on the website. See appendix for updated statistics for blog activity.
- **Political Director Application.** Posting the position and asking for applicants was a success, as it shows there is interest for such volunteer positions outside the State Committee.

B. Social Media

- **Facebook.** Event page set up for the State Convention. As of January 7, 2017, 27 said they are going and 70 are interested.

- **Twitter.** No updates. Twitter handle is @thelpny and graphics will need to be created for the account. Once we do that, we can start tweeting, sharing posts, etc. We are searching for volunteers to help run the Twitter account. We have at least one volunteer.

C. MailChimp

- Number of people opening e-mails has been steady for the past two campaigns. There were several clicks on the e-mail announcing the date of the 2018 convention. See appendix for statistics.
- The Press List was added to MailChimp in order to send the press release on the MOVE Act to our press list. 102 people opened the e-mail a total of 134 times. 53 e-mails bounced and 2 people unsubscribed. There were a total of 526 recipients for the press list.
- For your information. The current allocation of \$60 per month covers up to 5,600 e-mails. There are currently 5,322 in the list. Next e-mail should go out in the next week.

D. CiviCRM Database

- **CiviCRM.** An open source customer relationship management platform used to manage data.

- National Data. The data for New York has been added to the CiviCRM database.
- Edit Access. Edit access for State Administrators will be granted soon.
- **Civihosting.** Database has been moved to Civihosting and they will no longer use WPEngine.
 - We need to purchase an SSL Certificate for \$50 (https://civihosting.com/sslpurch/) in order to secure submission of form data to the database (such as volunteer inquiries, candidate inquiries, and e-mail newsletter sign-up)

E. Press Releases / Media Relations

- **Committee.** Current volunteers for the Media & Press Subcommittee are Hesham El-Meligy, Rich Purtell, and Kevin Wilson. Blog Editors are also given drafts of press releases for their input.
- **MOVE Act Press Release.** Independent Voter Network is the only press contact out of 500+ that I sent our press release that wrote an article: https://ivn.us/2017/12/12/bill-empower-military-voters-used-hurt-third-parties-new-york/

II. Upcoming Projects

A. Facebook

- **Streamlining and Support.** This will involve providing resources to chapters to help them better manage their Facebook pages, whether it is looking at statistics, working to gain likes and followers, or help with settings (such as URL) and graphics.
- **Hootsuite.** This is a social media manager. One possible use would be to have multiple Facebook pages, for example, unreached counties, in which State News can be sent to those county pages and we can receive messages from people interested in getting involved locally in those chapters. There is a cost, but we can research additional options.
- **Ad Campaigns.** The Communications Division will look into using Facebook ad campaigns for outreach and fundraising. Research shall be conducted to increase effectiveness.

B. How-To Guides

- **Videoconferencing.** I plan to set up a step-by-step guide for divisions, committees, and chapters to take advantage of the technology of videoconferencing to conduct meetings. I tested this out with my chapter and the advantages for use by other chapters are plenty.
- **LP Mail Accounts.** I plan to also set up a step-by-step guide for setting up your LP Mail account on different platforms (e-mail applications, mobile devices, etc.).

C. Website Store

• It has been discussed that we should have an online store on the website to sell branded LPNY merchandise. This could go along with fundraising and outreach.

D. Paper Newsletter

• For members without e-mail addresses, we can explore getting news to them that we post on the blog and Facebook page, possibly in the form of a paper newsletter, much like Free New York was conducted years ago, except in an updated, modern format.
