Secretary's Report: October convention minutes with minor spelling corrections and September minutes were presented. Motion by Mr. Peterson to approve the minutes with corrections was seconded by Mr. Morlock and passed unanimously.

Treasurer's Report: Andrew Kolstee

Account balance: \$443.44. No change. Motion by Mr. Morlock to accept the treasurer's report was seconded by Mr. Peterson and passed unanimously

State Committee Report: Andrew Kolstee

Efforts focused on getting out the vote for Jorgensen/Cohen. ~47K votes in NYS. Final tally pending.

Game plan for 2021. Grow the party and volunteer base. Strong statewide ticket in 2022.

Loss of ballot access will not greatly damage the party at the state level because of safeguards in the rules. The effect of the loss of ballot access for our county organization is likely to be small since petitioning thresholds for local races much lower.

Legal challenges to election law changes are still in play.

Discussion of Free Chautauqua Campaign for County Legislature seats and general strategy.
