





From the Editor **Repudiating Racism**

by Thomas M. Sipos

n July 29, I discussed he Libertarian Party at Los Angeles Trade Tech, a college in downtown L.A. Representatives from the Green Party and Peace and Freedom Party also gave talks.

As in June at Glendale Community College, I addressed issues of interest to youth, such as our opposition to drugs laws, war, and imperialism. I also said that hate crime laws are counter-productive, and that most Americans voluntarily, even passionately, fight bigotry. I distributed my Libertarian Perspective op-ed on the issue: http://ca.lp.org/ lp20061128.shtml.

Whenever a group opposes hate crime laws, the suspicion arises that that group has a secret, bigoted agenda. To prove otherwise, I cited the case of Sonny Landham.

Landham was the Kentucky LP's candidate for U.S. Senate. Then on July 21, Joseph Gerth of the Louisville Courier-Journal quoted Landham as saying: "We should go and bomb those camel-dung shovelers back into the sand.... I said 'camel-dung shovelers.' Make sure you put that in the newspaper."

IndependentPoliticalReport. com said Landham expressed "support for genocide against Arabs and Muslims... called for an end to all immigration from Arab and Muslim nations, nationalization of businesses which employ 'illegal' immigrants, and nationalization of rental property of landlords who rent to them ... a call for economic nationalism and protectionism, particularly of the steel industry. Landham said that the federal government should reorganize the economy as a

Selfish Goals, Altruist Gains

nurderous, deceiving, hateful, and abusive. Such is the protagonist of Paul Thomas Anderson's 2007 film, There Will Be Blood, loosely based on Upton Sinclair's 1927 novel Oil! The film is also a remarkable demonstration of how laissez-faire capitalism works to benefit consumers, despite efforts to the contrary by so-called robber barons.

Plainview is a man driven to succeed financially. He wears a firearm to his one-man mine in the middle of nowhere. His first stop after an almost fatal workplace injury is not to the physician, but to sell the ore he's dragged to town along with his own broken body.

His initial success leads to his supervising a team of oil drillers, one of whom dies in another accident (if nothing else. the film illustrates the hazards of mining), leaving Plainview to ineptly care for the worker's orphan, H.W. Far from being motivated by altruism, Plainview has H.W. earn his keep as a murder, assault, reneging on silent and valuable prop in his contracts) violate common law, land negotiations.



the poster child for what's wrong with that economic system. He takes advantage of the poor, drains their natural resources, makes a handsome profit, and outmaneuvers opposition with questionable tactics. A self-proclaimed misanthrope, Plainview's satisfaction comes from denying success and gain to others.

But Plainview is hardly evil because of laissez-faire. He's evil because he's evil. And much of his wrongdoings (e.g., not the nuances of anti-trust and corporate regulations.

The extent to which laissezfaire allows Plainview to chan-



capitalism, with Plainview being so as to deliver oil to consumers, must be recognized as being good. In the "anti-competitive" oil market of early 20th century America, Plainview is ultra-competitive. He is so concerned with besting Standard Oil, he invests enormous capital and assumes extraordinary risk. His irrational behavior in the face of a lucrative buyout offer emphasizes that the pipeline isn't so much about lining his pockets, as denying the same to Standard Oil.

To what end? Who ben-

Consumers benefit. People like Plainview curtail corporate power under laissez-faire Plainview symbolizes those entrepreneurs who would bring inexpensive goods and vast choices to the masses, even when those actions defy financial logic. Plainview is that deranged; that irrational. We should thank him for it.

There Will Be Blood was nominated for eight Oscars, winning Best Actor for Daniel Day-Lewis's depiction of Plainview and Best Cinematography for Robert Elswit.

"gay rights activists are wrong to petition the government for 'equal' marital status. This demand merely perpetuates the politicization of what should be a private issue. Gay rights activists would better serve their interests by arguing that the government should not be in the marriage business in the first place." See: http://ca.lp.

To understand why Summers is wrong, consider this thought experiment: The year is not 2008, but 1948. The issue is not whether to grow government by allowing gays and lesbians into government marriage, but instead whether to grow government by allowing black children into government schools.

Now change Summers's statement to read: "black civil rights activists are wrong to petition the government for 'equal' government schools. This demand merely perpetuates the politicization of what should be a private issue. Black civil rights activists would better serve their interests by arguing that the government should not be in the education business in the first place."

Despite being opposed to government schools, most libertarians would be horrified to see such a pro-segregation argument coming from the Reason Foundation. Yet they are less surprised when a nearly identical argument is made regarding gays and les-

"Unfortunately," said Lee "governments do whatever i takes to perpetuate the flow of taxpayer dollars, even at the expense of good fiscal judgment and truthfulness." He added that Seaside has a serious problem with an "overgenerous retirement program." Almost 40 Seaside public employees make over \$100,000 a year, a 144% increase since 2006. "Paying more and more in taxes is like trying to fill a bucket punctured with holes," Lee said.

Seaside recently received a huge infusion of money. Measure R, the 1% sales tax increase that was passed earlier this year, is estimated to provide a new revenue stream of approximately \$6 million this fiscal year. The repeal of the utility tax will return a little over \$2 million to Seaside citizens.

Furthermore, the Seaside Taxpayers Association claims that at least half of the 6% utility tax is illegal. The city of Seaside never put the utility tax up for a vote by the people, as required under the Jarvis-Gann Amendment.

Most cities do not tax utilities, because it appears that the state of California never gave cities this authority. Only a court case can settle this dispute.
