Dear Dr. Ruwart and Members of the Judicial Committee,

To supplement the initial LPD appeal, I would like to add several items for the record.

1. Mr. Will McVay has stated openly in interviews available to the public that he violated libertarian principles and ethics when employing the tactics and methods he used to attempt his takeover of the Libertarian Party of Delaware.
2. Mr. McVay's public admissions of wrongdoing including his participation in the illicit plot, and for record Mr. McVay self identifies this action as a "plot" which was in fact a conspiracy. This conspiracy subverts the 2021 state convention by first disregarding the ballots cast by the members of the party in elections and second by removing all credentialed members from the LPD and establishing an undefined litmus test to be a credentialed party member going forward, effectively disenfranchising every Libertarian in the state of Delaware.
3. In his local affiliate, the Kent County Libertarian party, Mr. McVay has been found guilty of misconduct on multiple specifications related to these activities and has been stripped of his county Chairmanship as well as his county representative position to the LPD. Mr. McVay's activities have damaged the good name of the national Libertarian Party and its affiliate, the Libertarian Party of Delaware.
4. All of the evidence of his misconduct was presented to the LNC immediately following the misdeeds on October 1st. The LNC members failed to scrutinize the evidence and a petition from a majority of convention attendees presented well prior to the meeting of November 21. Due to the LNC's inaction in the meeting Mr. McVay was allowed to continue to operate illegitimately as the self-proclaimed Chair of the LP of Delaware.

The LNC's inaction in this matter constructively disaffiliated the Libertarian party of Delaware by allowing these rogue actors to continue to operate. We further consider the inaction of the LNC on November 21 to have aided and abetted the theft of party assets, including monetary and social media accounts.

We are seeking relief from this injustice asking that the duly elected board be recognized by the LNC or the LPD be disaffiliated as a result of our appeal to the judiciary committee.
