



MEETING SUMMARY September 17, 2024

The meeting was called to order at 5:01pm Mountain time.

Records of Past Meetings: The minutes of the 3 September meeting were approved without objection.

Categories: James expressed concern about how to handle uncategorized pages, citing the LP SCC year-by-year history series as an example; Joe said they are just part of the history of the LP SCC so it should be sufficient to just put them in the LP SCC category. Caryn Ann said as long as she is still working on rebuilding the categories more generally others should not try to address issues like this.

Site Statistics: Sam said there hasn't been much change and that he will try to have a written report for the next meeting.

Featured Article: Joe reported that he switched the article discussed last time (Michael Rebmann) to be the featured article.

Site Technical: James said that several of the special pages about which he had been concerned did finally get updated, after about one month, so it may be that things are set up for them to be updated monthly. Sam said he will look into whether this is being done by a cron job that we could change to run more often.

Uploading Projects: Caryn Ann reminded the committee that we have a lot of material that still needs to be uploaded.

Nolan Collection: Nathan Madden said he has limited time to work on this but would be willing to help with quick tasks. Andrew said he had to defer his meeting
