CANDIDATE TO POLL FAIRGOERS ON ISSUES OF THE DAY

Jerry Tuccille (pronounced "two-chilly"), accompanied by his wife and children, will visit three New York county and State fairs as part of his campaign for governor, a spokesman at his Manhattan headquarters announced today.

Tuccille, who only last month made a whirlwind press trip around New York State via private aircraft, will follow up on that successful campaign tour with appearances at the Dutchess County Fair, the Fulton-Montgomery County Fair, and the State Fair at Syracuse.

His campaign organization will operate a booth at each of the Fairs in order to poll visitors on their views. "I'm not coming to tell people what I think," said Tuccille, "but rather to find out what they think."

The candidate kicks off his trip with a visit to the Dutchess County Fair on Saturday and Sunday, August 24th and 25th. He will share a booth with Sandy Cohen, his party's candidate for the 25th Congressional District.

Tuccille's next scheduled stop is the Fulton-Montgomery County Fair on Saturday, August 31st. He'll arrive between one and two p.m.

On Sunday and Monday, September 1st and 2nd, Tuccille winds up his tour with an appearance at the State Fair at Syracuse.

Tuccille noted that while he did not expect to be elected governor, his goal was to "send the politicians a message they cannot ignore"-- 50,000 votes. "That many votes will put our party permanently on the ballot in New York State, and make it an effective, continuing lobby on behalf of the individual citizen." The candidate added that his campaign workers have collected 20,000 signatures, which will guarantee him a line on the ballot this year.
