COMMITTEE OVERVIEW

Policy Manual Section 2.02 SCOPE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Historical Preservation Committee

The HPC shall be responsible for directing the preservation and publication of Party historical documents and the administration of LPedia.org. A report of its decisions and activities shall be delivered at each LNC meeting.

The scope of the initial organizing work will last well into several years (the estimate is at least additional five years depending on member involvement), and LPedia will need to be maintained for the time of its existence.

Status of search for potential additions to committee:

Ms. Mosashvil was added after extensive interviews. There remains one potential vacancy to be filled by the right candidate. STORAGE FACILITY

The Parker storage facility experienced a dramatic raise in rent, so after exploration, and working with Robert Kraus, a new facility was found in Littleton at the rate similar to what we were paying at the time of the beginning of this project, and it is slightly larger. The new location may allow volunteers who live in that area of Colorado to participate who may not have been willing to travel to Parker. The safety of the neighborhood is equivalent. The next few weeks will be occupied with moving the items.

Restructuring

The restructuring of the chaotic state of the original site continues as it is very time and planning intensive. There is a light at the end of the tunnel. Caryn Ann Harlos has been working on the logical category tree and is currently going through assigning categories to all images going back over a decade. When that is completed, a second pass over all of the categories will be conducted and is expected to be completed by this term end leaving Lpedia in a much more sustainable and logical state.

Policies

At the request of the LNC, the policies regarding delegates were reviewed, and any personal information other than name and state have been removed. It is noted however, that these lists exist elsewhere on the Internet as any member can request them, and at least some of our copies were received from third parties, not the Party itself. However, moving forward, those columns in the spreadsheets shall be suppressed. Additionally, we created a template and strengthened the policy on “disputed or controversial material” in light of recent controversies in the Party as it is not the job of Lpedia to take sides but simply to record history (see https://lpedia.org/wiki/LPedia:Disputed_or_Controversial_Material). This is the notice that is placed on such articles:

ACCOUNTING FOR CURRENT YEAR AND LIFE OF COMMITTEE

It has always been our goal to self-fundraise for the Committee expenses, and over the life of the Committee this has been accomplished. Since inception the Committee has raised \$22.5K in revenue, and there's been \$22.2K in expenses. YTD there has been \$3.0K in revenue and \$3.2K in expenses.
