ovember will be a busy month for local Libertarians, as we field a full slate of candidates in hotly-contested partisan and non-partisan races.

In addition to the state office candidates (Rob Fliegler for 8th Senate District, Mike Denny for 12th Assembly District, Robert Giedt for 19th Assembly District, Raymond Bell for 21st Assembly District, and Elisabeth Brierly for 1st State Board of Equalization

District), we have a well-publicized U.S. Congress race where Maad Abu-Ghazalah is running in the 12th Congressional District and Andrew Carver is running in the 14th Congressional District.

We're also waging a battle in the Sequoia Health Care District race, fielding six candidates for the available positions: Warren Gibson, Harland Harrison, Jack Hickey, Arthur Bates, Sonya Sigler, and Philip Brattain. We should have an excellent chance to fill seats on this board! (Vote for three.)

### **Candidates Earn Record Number of Outside Endorsements**

Sequoia Healthcare District: The slate of Warren Gibson, Harland Harrison, and Jack Hickey has received an unprecedented amount of press and TV coverage, for Libertarians seeking nonpartisan office.

Warren was endorsed by the San Mateo County Independent Newspaper Group.

Warren and Jack were both endorsed by the San Mateo County Times, the Redwood City Daily News, and the Mexican American Political Association (MAPA). Jack was additionally endorsed by the Howard Jarvis Taxpayers Association (HJTA).



Mike Denny was also endorsed by the San Francisco Small Business Advocates.

#### **Local Ballot Measures**

In August, the LPSM central committee voted to oppose three tax and bond measures on local ballots: Measure A, a parcel tax in the Belmont-Redwood Shores school district; Measure B, a property tax and bond in the Hillsborough city school district, and Measure H, ratification of the illegally collected utility tax in East Palo Alto.

The *LPSM* authored forceful arguments against all of the above measures, and the first two appear in voters' ballot pamphlets. (We deferred to the citizens who forced the utility tax onto the ballot in East Palo Alto.)

Your publisher urges a vote against Measure D, ratification of an increase in the utility tax on businesses in Pacifica. Back in August, the city misrepresented the measure as capping the utility tax, so we took no action at that time. @#\$&!
