A motion to *postpone indefinitely* the question of a platform was carried overwhelmingly by the Convention.

Out of 22 proposed By-Laws amendments, 10 were adopted. Copies of the revised By-Laws will be sent to all members.

A resolution to have the Party write a letter to all New York State legislators urging repeal of all contraception laws was approved.

A resolution to have the FLP write a letter to each State legislator in support of the Liberty Amendment was approved.

Among the featured speakers were Harry Browne who spoke on how each person can get *freedom in our lifetime*, Murray Rothbard who spoke on *the need for a libertarian movement and party*, and Paul Lepanto who addressed himself to *when it doesn't matter who writes the laws*.
