The 2022 State Convention *Redux* of the Libertarian Party of Idaho will be held
Saturday, August 27th.

Our convention in April this year was the first year a convention was held before the completion of county canvassing, which did not account for May 17th Primary election; excluding any potentially elected or appointed precinct committeemen, county central committee officers, or legislative district officers. In order to comply with [Idaho election law](#) the LPID is rehosting its 2022 election. We have worked closely with the Secretary of States office to ensure that the April 2nd business, including the selection of national delegates, are still valid. As such *this convention's agenda will only include the internal party elections for officers and judicial committee*. Platform and Bylaw changes will be addressed at the pending 2023 convention.

This event is anticipated to be a hybrid event to encourage attendance of LPID delegates* from across the state.

* Delegates to the 2022 LPID Convention are defined as a person who:

Per LPID Bylaws Article V Section 3:

Convention attendees may not vote unless they were members in good standing of the Party as of the end of January prior to the convention.

Per LPID Bylaws Article III Section 2:

a) Has signed a statement agreeing with the Non-Aggression Principle (NAP); and

b) Has paid minimum dues required for membership to the State Party within the last 12 consecutive months, or is a lifetime member; and

c) As defined by Idaho State Law is either:

1) A Qualified Elector registered as Libertarian or Unaffiliated; or

2) A resident of Idaho, who is not registered to vote.
