Dear Members of the Judicial Committee,

I apologize if this point has already been made, but looking at the briefs sent to the committee thus far I haven't seen the following point specifically made.

Per Article 14, Section 4 of the Libertarian Party Bylaws:

"The National Committee **shall respect the vote of the delegates at nominating conventions and provide full support for the Party's nominee for President and nominee for Vice-President** as long as their campaigns are conducted in accordance with the platform of the Party." (emphasis added)

Chase Oliver and Mike ter Maat were elected as the nominees for President and Vice President respectively at the 2024 Libertarian Convention. The campaign for these candidates conducted their campaign in accordance with the platform of the party, and to the best of my knowledge there was no effort made to say otherwise.

I have direct knowledge that the campaign team for Mr. Oliver and Mr. ter Maat reached out to the LNC Secretary, Ms. Harlos, asking that she send the appropriate documentation regarding their nominations to the Colorado Secretary of State.

Ms. Harlos was doing her duty as the duly elected Secretary of the LNC, per the Bylaws, in providing that documentation to the Colorado Secretary of State. Therefore, I believe that this is certainly not cause for removal from the position of Secretary.
