TUCCILLE CONCEDES ELECTION BUT NOT VICTORY;
CLAIMS 50,000 VOTES CERTAIN

Jerry Tuccille, Free Libertarian Party candidate for governor, conceded the election to his Democratic opponent today at 1:00 p.m.

"Hugh Carey will win the election," said Tuccille. "But the real victory--for us and the people of New York--is the 50,000 votes that the FLP is certain to achieve."

Tuccille predicted that his party would be the first in 12 years to win official recognition under the New York State law that grants a permanent ballot line to any party obtaining 50,000 gubernatorial votes.

"The middle-class New Yorker is plagued by inflation, taxes and governmental infringements on individual freedom," continued Tuccille. "The Republicans and Democrats have nothing to offer as a solution to these problems but the same Welfare State policies that have failed repeatedly. People have come to recognize the bankruptcy of the major parties. It is those people who will help to make the Free Libertarian Party a permanent citizens' lobby for reduced taxes and increased individual freedom."

Tuccille offered his assistance to Governor Carey "in any project he undertakes which will lead to deregulation, decontrol or decriminalization."

Climaxing the tremendous amount of media coverage Tuccille and the libertarians have received in this campaign is a full-page story in the current issue of Newsweek (11 November, p. 91).
