LIBERTARIANS NOMINATE SICILIA FOR LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR.

The Free Libertarian Party endorsed Louis J. Sicilia as its candidate for Lieutenant-Governor of New York State at its annual State Convention in Manhattan on March 31.

In accepting the nomination, Mr. Sicilia stated, "Libertarianism is an idea whose time has come. The vast government bureaucracies that have proliferated over the years have proven to be grossly inefficient. The bureaucracies give less and less in return for a larger and larger share of the taxpayers' income. Every year more bureaus, commissions, divisions, departments, boards and even public corporations are created to regulate and control both the economy and our private lives. The time is now, in this campaign, to tell the people there's another way to go. We can have a truly free society when private initiative, creativity, and the free market replace compulsory governmental 'solutions' and no attempt is made to regulate an individual's private life-style."

Louis Sicilia, 39 years old, was born and raised on Manhattan's upper West Side. He was Borough President. He organized the Libertarian Anti-Censorship Committee and has been active in anticensorship activities. Mr. Sicilia was one of the founders and currently Treasurer of New Yorkers for Abortion Law Repeal, an organization which is against any restrictive abortion laws.
