16 LIBERTARIAN CANDIDATES FILE PETITIONS ACROSS STATE

May 30, 2023 was the deadline for filing independent petitions. Despite the State of New York's attempts to kill third parties, we still have candidates running. A total of 16 Libertarian candidates have filed petitions to be placed on the general election ballot this fall.

In Chautauqua County, incumbent Sherman Village Trustee and Deputy Mayor is running for relection to another 4-year term. Sanders was the first Libertarian to be elected to office in Chautauqua County.

In Chemung County, Craig Colwell is running for Elmira City Council in District 6. Colwell is the County Affiliate's Chair and ran for County Legislature in 2022.

In Chenango County, Tom Quiter is running for Supervisor in the Town of Guilford. Quiter is the County Affiliate's Chair and previously ran for U.S. Senate in 2022 and State Senate in 2020.

In Erie County, LPNY 1st Vice-Chair Duane Whitmer is running for County Executive. He previously ran for Congress (2020)

and County Comptroller (2021).

In Madison County, LPNY Secretary Mark Braiman is running for Cazenovia Town Council.

In Oneida County in the Town of Ava, there are two candidates: Keith Redhead for Town Supervisor and Kathleen Redhead for Town Tax Collector.

In Onondaga County, Craig Shute is running for Lafavette Town Supervisor.

In Niagara County, Wendi Szabo is running for Royalton Town Council.

In Steuben County, incumbent Prattsburgh Town Councilwoman Angela Einwachter is running for re-election.

In Yates County, there are three candidates running for County Legislature in District 3, in which there are 4 positions available: Jeff Bradley, Jan Enos, and Phillip Rahr. All three are officers

In Ulster County, there are three candidates: Suzanne Timbrouch for County Legislature District 3, Chris Madden for County Legislature District 19, and Michael Kavanagh for District Attorney.

DO WE NEED LESS GOVERNING?

Do we need less governing?

"There are two possible ways for people to relate to each other, either voluntarily or coercively."" - Doug Casey

Let's start by distinguishing force from power...real power attracts cooperation; it has little need for force.

When a government can't depend on allegiance and voluntary compliance it must force obedience. As government demands submission the question becomes: How much and what kind of submission is acceptable?

'Government' is just a different word for 'Law'. A government's legitimacy and moral right to use state power is only justified and lawful when consented to by the people. Otherwise it is forced on people. An ideal government requires no forced obedience because people voluntarily consent to the laws.

Should values be forced on us and choices restricted by any party? Those who complain about government ought to strive for less of it but all they really do is complain about not having enough of it to impose their rule over others. Can't we try to liberate instead of regulate each other? Wasn't America supposed to be about individual liberty instead of forced obedience?

All laws steal choices. They create privileges for some and steal inalienable rights from others in the process. They prohibit and limit choices for some people and make you obey someone else's choices. It's like being told where to sit on the bus. Laws can make you do things you would not want to do if you were free. Was it meant to be this way?

What can be more valuable than choice? What do you have when you have no choice?

HELP US PASS A3312

This bill will lower the ballot access thresholds back to the previous standards: the number of votes needed to

get ballot access to 50,000 (from 130,000 or 2%), and

lower the petition signature requirement for a statewide office to 15,000 (from 45,000). Contact your representatives in the New York State Legislature and ask them to support this bill!


