As per our Bylaws Article VI, Section 3j, the duties of the Treasurer are as follows:

The Treasurer shall be responsible for maintaining accurate records of all income and expenses associated with the operation of the Party and shall present a summary of all income and expenses at each regular meeting of the Board. The income and expense summary may be limited to activity since the last regular meeting of the Board. The Treasurer may also prepare budgets for the other Directors or assist them in preparing their own budgets. The Treasurer shall maintain an efficient double-entry system of accounts.

As of October 3, 2023, PNC Bank state account balance was \$560.22

As of October 3, 2023, FEC account balance was \$2,103.23

As of October 3, 2023, cash on hand was \$0

As of October 3, 2023, AVAILABLE FUNDS was approximately \$33,493.93, though that is working with incomplete access to all accounts. I will be rectifying that in the next week and have an accurate figure by next report.

I have been elected Treasurer in the last month and have been working towards access to all relevant information for my position.

We have been interviewing people for the soon to be created Standing Audit Committee. I will be inputting all entries for the quarterly report in the next two weeks. We are currently interviewing candidates for the Assistant Treasurer position. Once I have caught up with the position and have support in place moving forward, I plan on addressing the budget and restarting our double entry bookkeeping system through digital means. This will allow more transparency for my position and ensure the fiduciary duties are upheld appropriately.

- LPCO Twitter account was recovered
 - Goal is to now monetize the account to generate revenue for the party.
 - Requires 5 million impressions over a 3 month period to monetize the account.
 - In 17 days since recovering the account, we've gained 532K impressions.
 - At this rate, we're just under 3M impressions over a 3 month period.

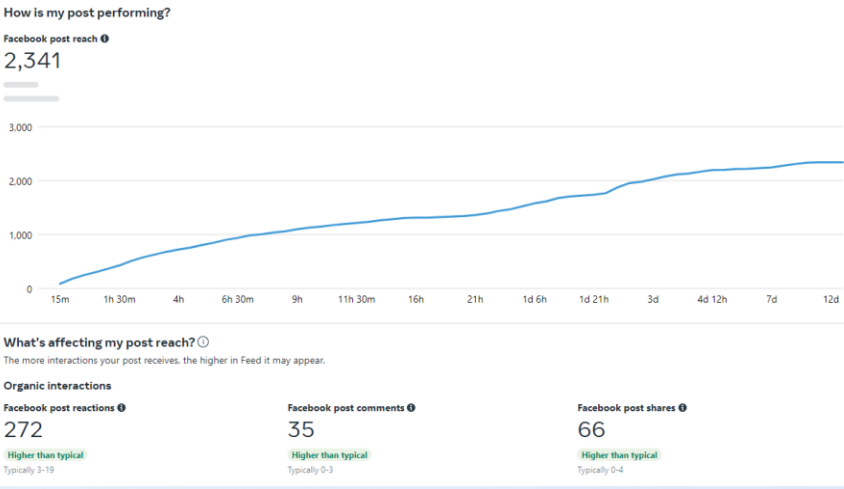

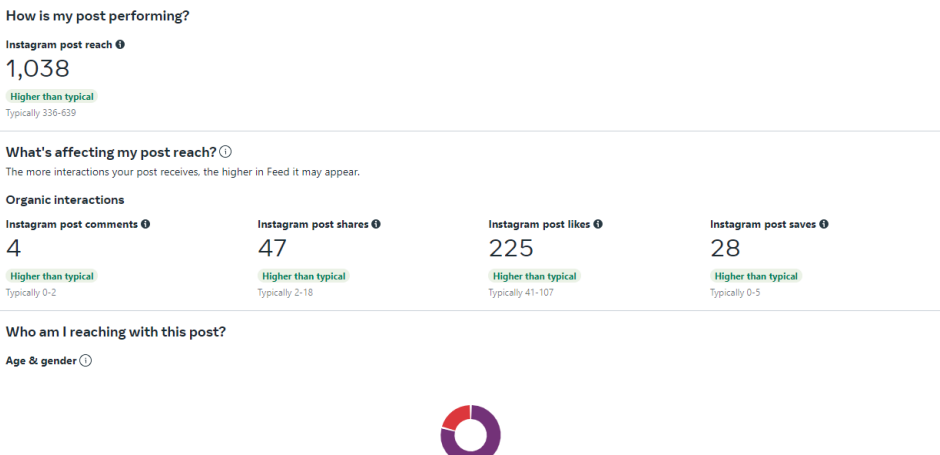
