

MINUTES OF THE LIBERTARIAN PARTY OF NEW YORK STATE
COMMITTEE TELECONFERENCE, MAY 6, 2007

A quorum was established and Chairman Russell called the meeting to order at 2000.

Dr. Stevens introduced a resolution endorsing the candidacy of William Schmidt for Mayor of Peekskill. (Passed.)

Minutes of the March and April teleconferences, and of the State LP convention, were approved.

It was agreed without objection to schedule monthly teleconferences for the first Sunday of every month, to be changed at the discretion of the Chairman.

Dr. Stevens proposed approval as delegates to the 2008 LP national convention of all names on the list of volunteers collected at the state convention, the remainder to be appointed by the State Committee at a later time. (Accepted without objection.)

Chairman Russell asked for help in setting up a fundraising Website. The possibility of adjusting annual and lifetime dues was discussed, and it was agreed without objection that annual dues will be \$15, and lifetime membership \$200, until August 31 of this year, with an increase to be considered at a future meeting. The prospect of cooperation among the Manhattan, Brooklyn, and Queens chapters, with a view to New York City hosting the 2008 state convention, was discussed. Strategy for recruitment and fundraising during Pridefest was discussed.

The meeting adjourned at 2102.
