

Good morning registrant to the NM organizing convention for potential affiliation with the national Libertarian Party. This email is being sent on behalf of the meeting organizers. I am not a meeting organizer, merely a facilitator for them from the national party representing the interests of the national party. If you are getting this email this means you are attending as a guest and not a voting member as you do not meet the credentialing requirements of:

1. A National Party Member on or before October 13, 2022
2. A resident of New Mexico

If you believe this in error, please raise this at the meeting for resolution and bring with you any proof you have of meeting these requirements.

Guests are fully welcome to attend.

There are also two resolutions scheduled to be moved which are presently worded as follows:

*Resolved, Robert's Rules of Order, Newly Revised, 12th Edition, shall be the parliamentary authority adopted for the organizing meeting of the Free Libertarian Party of New Mexico.*

*Resolved, To organize a new society to work towards functioning as a qualified political party within the laws of the state of New Mexico as an affiliate of the national Libertarian Party and to apply for affiliation with same upon adoption of bylaws.*

Presuming that bylaws with provisos are adopted close to the form written, there will be elections of certain directors at this meeting who will serve until the March 2023 convention.

Also attached are pdfs of two documents. The first is a petition for affiliation. If there are bylaws adopted and certain director positions elected, qualified members (which may include some of you if you are a New Mexico resident but joined the national party after October 13, 2022, including joining today) be asked to sign the petition. If you would like to be part of the New Mexicans signing the petition, you can join the national party right now at [lp.org/join](http://lp.org/join). The petition cannot be signed and submitted until after the national statement of principles is ratified (which is in the proposed bylaws), bylaws are adopted, and a Chair, Vice Chair, Secretary, and Treasurer are elected per the National Bylaws. After these are done, those who wish to sign the petition can handwrite in the names of the elected board (the rest of the information will be sent in a cover email to national), sign the petition, and send a photograph or scan of it to this email address. Alternatively, an Adobe electronic signature option will be presented at the meeting.

The second pdf is a membership for the potential new affiliate. This is how the form will look if the proposed bylaws are adopted with the present wording of the membership article. If that

article is changed, this form may change. The same options are available for you to fill out by hand and email back to this address (unless it changes via amendment) or for an Adobe electronic signature. New Mexico residency is required, but national party membership is not, so far.
