Dear Irene:

As I mentioned to you on the phone. I appeared on Mr. Farber's show about a year ago and would like to come on again to discuss "Kill Lib."

There is tremendous de facto and de jure discrimination against children in this country. Children are compelled by law to go to school till they are a certain age; they have no legal redress against their parents. I propose that we respect the rights of children, full rights as granted to every human being — including the right of children to "fire" their parents. I propose the elimination of compulsory education (no tax-supported education and no compulsory school attendance). Children should have the same rights as adults.

I am now a New York City Attorney with the Legal Aid Society; formerly, as Assistant District Attorney of Queens County I functioned as Deputy Chief Assistant in charge of the Youth Corps. I am a former law assistant to Congressman Halpern and one-time candidate for Judge on the Conservative ticket in Suffolk County.
