The motion passed, the yeas being 10 and the nays being 3. (FOR: Becker, Beeman, Capozzi, Cooper, Padgett, Popkin, Risino, Russell, Sherman, Sundwall. AGAINST: Dobrian, MacAskill, Stevens.)

Moved by Mr. Dobrian, and seconded: That the State Committee authorizes Mr. Edes to put together the next issue of Free New York, together with a fund-raising letter, and to send it out by e-mail to members whose addresses we have, and by postal mail to other members, and that he be reimbursed for postage and supplies.

Dr. Stevens moves to amend by adding: "up to \$200." Amendment passes by unanimous consent.

Main motion passes on voice vote.

Mr. Donoyan gave a report on the ballot access situation in Suffolk County.
