TUCCILLE TO ERECT PYRAMID AT ALBANY MALL,
SYMBOLIZING COERCIVE NATURE OF PROJECT

Jerry Tuccille (pronounced "two-chilly"), Free Libertarian Party candidate for governor, will kick off his third campaign tour of upstate New York by erecting what he calls "a monument to the taxpayer" at the Albany Mall.

Tuccille and his entourage will arrive at the Mall at 3:30 p.m. on Friday, 11 October. At four p.m. a demonstration will begin, with Tuccille's campaign workers hoisting aloft a replica of an Egyptian pyramid.

"The point we're making," said Tuccille, "is that the method used to build the Mall does not differ in principle from that used to construct the pyramids of Ancient Egypt. Both were coercive, government projects, built as monuments to a few bigshots, at the expense of the average citizen.

"Thousands of years ago, people were forced to build pyramids. Today, people are still coerced into building grandiose and gratuitous 'public projects'--via taxation. Before the Albany Mall is completed, \$2 billion of the hard-earned money of New Yorkers will have paid for it."

On Saturday, 12 October, the Tuccille crew will leave Albany for Poughkeepsie, arriving at the Dutchess County Airport at 10:00 a.m. They'll move on to Binghamton at 1:00 p.m., and wind up the day in Ithaca starting at 5:30. Several public appearances are planned for each city.

A full day in Buffalo is on the docket for Sunday, 13 October.

Syracuse is the scheduled stop for Monday the 14th. Highlighting the Syracuse visit will be a celebration of Columbus Day at Columbus Square.

The tour will end with a motorcade across Suffolk and Nassau counties on Tuesday the 15th.

Albany's WAST (Channel 13) is airing the Tuccille anti-tax TV commercial through the remainder of the campaign. The imaginative 30-second spot, presently receiving wide exposure in the New York metropolitan area, represents the only use of television advertising by a minor-party candidate in New York.
